RESOLUTION NO. -2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A BID FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF ROLL-UP DOORS AT THE NORTH HEMPSTEAD TRANSFER STATION (SWMA004-2020).

WHEREAS, the Town of North Hempstead Director of Purchasing (the “Director”), on behalf of the Town of North Hempstead Solid Waste Management Authority (the “Authority”), has solicited bids for the replacement of the roll-up doors at the North Hempstead Transfer Station (SWMA004-2020); and

WHEREAS, bids in response to the solicitation (the “Bids”) were received and were opened, which Bids are as follows; and

WHEREAS, following a site visit, United Steel Products, Inc. determined that it would reuse the existing mount angles for the rolling steel doors in both phase 1 and phase 2 of the project thereby reducing the pricing in its bid as follows: Phase 1 - \$304,310.97 and Phase 2 - \$246,250.45 for a total bid price, without the additional alternative, of \$550,561.42; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the bids, the Executive Director of the Authority has recommended that the contract for the Project be awarded to United Steel Products Inc., 33-40 127th Place, Flushing, NY 11368 (the “Contractor”), as the lowest responsible bidder for Phases 1 and 2 at its negotiated bid price of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty One and 42/100 Dollars (\$550,561.42), without the additional alternative; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to authorize the award of a contract to the Contractor as recommended by the Executive Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that a Contract for the Project is hereby awarded to the Contractor, as the lowest responsible bidder for Phases 1 and 2, at its negotiated bid price of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty One and 42/100 Dollars (\$550,561.42), without the additional alternative, as more particularly set forth in an agreement which will be filed in the Office of the Authority (the "Award"); and be it further

RESOLVED that the Chair of the Board of the Authority is hereby authorized to execute the contract documents, and to take such other action as may be necessary to effectuate the foregoing; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Office of the Town Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to supervise the execution of the contract documents to effectuate the Award; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Assistant Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay the cost thereof upon receipt of a duly executed contract and certified claims therefor.

RESOLUTION NO. -2020

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. s18-2020, ADOPTED AUGUST 13, 2020, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH OMNI RECYCLING OF WESTBURY, INC. IN CONNECTION WITH TROPICAL STORM ISAIAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. s18-2020, duly adopted on August 13, 2020, the Town of North Hempstead Solid Waste Management Authority (the “Authority”) was authorized to enter into an amendment to an agreement with OMNI Recycling of Westbury, Inc., 7 Portland Avenue, Westbury, New York 11590 (“OMNI”) to provide for OMNI to rent a grinder to grind and chip the storm debris resulting from Tropical Storm Isaias and deposited at the Landfill and the Transfer Station and retain personnel to operate the grinder, in consideration of payment by the Authority to OMNI of a rental fee, additional expenses and an operator charge of \$40.51 per hour (the “Resolution”); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has received guidance from the New York State Department of Labor that the OMNI grinder operator at the landfill will need to be paid a base and supplemental benefit prevailing wage rate under Article 8 of the Labor Law, and not Article 9 as previously concluded; and

WHEREAS, Article 8 requires that the labor rate for work at the landfill be increased to \$139.08 per hour (including multipliers required by the contractor); and

WHEREAS, the labor rate for work performed at the transfer station will be either \$40.51 per hour or \$139.08 per hour (inclusive of multipliers) depending on whether the work falls under Article 9 or Article 8 of the prevailing wage law; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Authority has requested that the Resolution be amended to correct the hourly amount to be paid by the Authority (the “Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, this Board finds it to be in the best interest of the Authority to authorize the Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Resolution be and hereby is amended to reflect the Amendment.
